PRACTICAL INFORMATION

1. Dates and times

- Arrival expected on Tuesday 21th May 2024 before lunch (12h00) at the hotel
- Departure on Friday 24th May 2024 *after lunch* around (14:00) from the hotel

<u>Travel arrangements should be made accordingly</u> to avoid arriving after the start of the TCA and leaving before the end.

The French agency will pay the following expenses directly from Tuesday 21 May 2024 (at the indicated time) to Friday 24 May 2024 (at the indicated time) - all-inclusive format:

- 3 nights of accommodation (breakfast included),
- lunches and dinner,
- a cocktail reception (dinner) with a buffet, usually served standing up, not just an aperitif, but multiple small bites (in verrines, spoons, picks, etc. served with drinks, free clothes,
- study visits, including transport by public bus,
- social activities (a guided tour of a site of interest, for example), etc.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Your national sending agency will book/manage the nights and additional costs directly if you
 wish to arrive before the date indicated or leave after the date indicated.
- In this case, any additional nights *must be booked by yourself or by your national agency* at the hotel of your choice or directly with the hotel where we will stay.
- Because of the Paris 2024 Olympic Games and the Roland Garros Tournament (from Monday 20 May to 9 June 2024), hotel accommodation may be particularly limited. Many regular Parisian events have had to be rescheduled before or after the summer.
- Good to know: Monday 20 May 2024 is a public holiday in France.

A ministerial inaugural sequence is also planned for 21 May 2024 (early afternoon).

On the evening of Monday 21 May 2024, a cocktail reception is planned, for dinner with a buffet, usually served standing up, not just an aperitif, but multiple small bites (in verrines, spoons, picks, etc. served with drinks.

4. Travel to Paris

From France, you can reach Paris by train (*transport to be favoured*): https://www.sncf-connect.com/en-en/

From European countries, it's possible to land at Roissy-Charles de Gaulle airport (international airport).

On arrival at Paris CDG international airport, you can take public transport to reach Montparnasse railway station by public transport (*Allow 1 hour's travel time*):

- ✓ Take the RER B from Charles De Gaulle 2 Airport (Terminal 2) Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG), France, *direction Pist* and **stop Denfert-Rochereau** https://www.transilien.com/en/page-lignes/ligne-b
- ✓ Take line 4 Metro from Denfert-Rochereau to Alesia (stop) https://www.ratp.fr/en/plans-lignes/metro/4
- ✓ From Alesia stop (line metro 4) by walk: 500 meters around 7 min.
